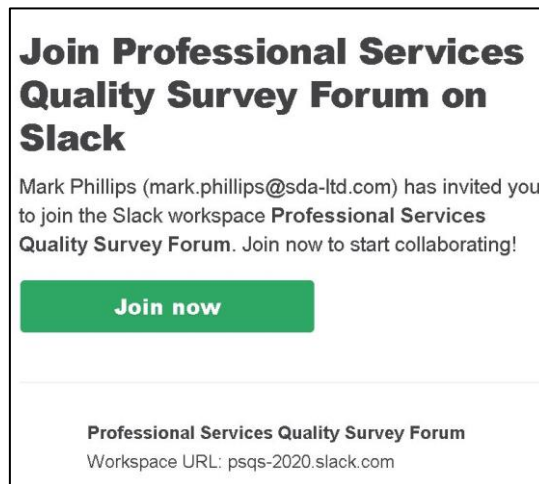


Guidance for joining the PSQS Participants Forum

1. Contact Mark Phillips (mark.phillips@sda-ltd.com) for your invitation. Note that invitations will only be accepted if you have an email address with an ac.uk suffix.
2. Mark will send you an email (via Slack) inviting you to join the psqs-2020.slack.com channel. Select 'Join now'.



3. You will be taken to the Slack site where you will be asked to provide your name and a password. Select 'Create Account'.

Passwords must be at least 6 characters long, and can't be things like "password", "123456" or "abcdef".
